Carter Middle School is designated as a Title I building as determined through the Michigan Department of Education. Title I is a supplemental program from the Federal Government which provides funds to our school to help students achieve high academic standards. It also means we are able to provide our students with specific classes, learning opportunities, and access to resources that would not normally be available with only using State funding. It also means the staff at Carter constantly evaluates the needs of our students and establishes rigorous goals in the areas of reading, writing, math, science, and social studies in order to benefit all students. The funds from the Federal Government help to establish and implement research-based programs to help our at-risk youth and to work with all stakeholders (teachers, parents, and community members). Some of the programs in place due to Title I are Math and Reading Intervention Support, Corrective Reading, and summer enrichment opportunities.

Under Federal law, the following specific information is available upon request:

- 1) Whether the teacher has met the State qualifications/licensing for their grade level/subjects
- 2) Whether the teacher is on a temporary permit or waiver
- 3) The teacher's majors, graduate certificates/degrees, and discipline fields
- 4) Paraprofessional services and qualifications
